GLOSSARY OF CHARACTERS



The Croatian Nobility

BARIC

Mauro/ Mauritius Radovan Baric: born 1624, Solgrad, Croatia. Fostered at Toth Castle from age 11. Well-traveled, careered army officer. Second son and reluctant heir to the Baric's barony. Forced marriage in 1648 to:

Paci/Terese Helana (Kokkinge): born 1628 in Thessalogiki. Upovpostedly.

Resi/Terese Helena (Kokkinos): born 1628 in Thessaloniki. Unexpectedly likable, beautiful, well-read daughter of a Greek sea trader.

Mateo (Matej): 1621-1636. Mauro's half-brother who drowned in the sea.

Lorenc: 1594-1647. Second son of Fredrik. Baron of Baric 1614-1647. Mauro's misunderstood father. Died at age 53 of an undetermined illness (or possibly murder). Married twice: in 1614 and again in 1623.

Margaret: 1595-1622. Beautiful, amusing, beloved first wife of Lorenc. Died with their three children in a plague.

Johanna: 1601-1648. Mauro's mother. Sister to Renata Toth. Second wife to Lorenc. Unhappy, with a personality disorder. Died suddenly at age 47.

Fredrik: 1567-1614 in a hunting accident. Mauro's grandfather. Politically caught up in Venice. Savvy trader. Generous patron. Widower. Married in 1590 to his beloved:

Anica: 1570-1601. Sons: Vladimir and Lorenc. Died birthing twin girls.

TOTH

Vladimir (Baric): Born 1592. Mauro's uncle. Regional governor, army general, titled count in 1613 after an advantageous marriage in 1612 to:

Renata: Countess. Lady Johanna's sister. Kind and generous to Mauro. **Petar**: born 1616. Eldest of Renata's four children. Heir to Toth County.

Traveled with Mauro as a youth. Mauro's least favorite cousin.

Dominik: Mauro's maternal grandfather. Influential Count. Died 1613.

LEOPOLD

Neven: Nearest neighbor to the south. Mateo's childhood friend. Mauro's newest confident. Navy occupies his port town. Married to:

Nikolina: Resi's aristocratic friend. Gossipy. Expecting her fourth child. Eleonora: Neven's widow mother. Dowager. Smart and well-informed. Karloff: Eleonora's husband. Neven's father. Killed by bandits in 1634. Cedomir: 1570-1639. Neven's grandfather. Didn't get along with Fredrik.

DUBOVIC

Sebastijan: Mauro's neighbor to the north. Landlord of an much over-sized barony. Scheming widower with two married daughters.

RANERI

Lord and Lady Raneri: Aristocratic landholder south of Leopold's estate. Attended the ball.

MARQUIS

Lord Marquis: Nobleman. Influential with the Venetian Navy. Landholder bordering the Republic of Ragusa. Attended the ball.

Meister Uberti: Baric sons' childhood tutor.

Lieutenant D'Alessandro: Commands the navy patrolling Croatian waters.

Stationed in Leopold's port town. Gambler who beds only virgins.

Captain Pasini: Second in command to D'Alessandro. **Orlando**: navy clerk and assistant to D'Alessandro.

Roberto Carrera: Fabian's father. Titled lord, councilman, wealthy silk merchant. Long-time friend of Lorenc and Vladimir.

Carrera Siblings in Venice:

Gabriel: born 1620. Married to Perla. Heir to the family fortune. Michele: born 1622 Newly married. Runs the family fabric business. Fabian Carrera: born 1624. Army Captain. Mauro's friend since 17. Cristina: born 1626. Married and a new mother. Isabella's friend. Caterina Carrera: born 1630. Engaged to Hungarian Viscount. Bianca: born 1633. Youngest. Newly introduced to society.

Paolo: Carrera guardsman. Caterina's secret lover.

Gino: Carrera guardsman.

Stephan Padovi: born 1625. Son of a prominent Venetian aristocrat. Army captain and childhood friend of Fabian. Madly in love with Mira.

Mira: young wealthy fiancée to Stephan.

Isabella Valli: born 1625. Daughter to a powerful Venetian politician. Caterina's traveling companion. Childhood friend to the Carrera siblings. **Alfonzo Valli**: Isabella's only sibling. Heir to the Valli family fortune.

Lady Rosella: Noblewoman, socialite, and Mauro's former lover.

Lord Marcellis: mentioned in a seduction trick with a Duchess.

Ottomans and Foreigners

Demetrius Kokkinos: Resi's father. Thessalonian ship captain, trader, Baric's broker. Imprisoned six years for stealing from Lord Lorenc.

Celine Kokkinos: Resi's Catholic mother, who met Demetrius while he traded in her native Kingdom of France.

Kokkinos Siblings in Thessaloniki:

Castor: born 1619. Sea captain for his father's fleet. Lives at the family

estate in Thessaloniki with his wife and their three children.

Alexis: Castor's wife.

Patricius/Patrik: born 1626. A mercenary sellsword since age 18. Terese/Resi: born 1628. Married Mauro to pay a family debt.

Hector: born 1638 Lander: born 1641 Phyllis: born 1646

Ruby (Rhoda) Spiros: born 1630. Greek friend and companion to Resi. **Angelos Spiros**: Ruby's father. Sea captain. Friend of Demetrius.

Salar Nassim: Born 1614. Persian sellsword and mercenary gang leader.

Wives: Hafza in Rhodes and Emine in Athens. Daughter, Shirin, is 16.

Bem (Emilio Chidubem Tavares): born 1625. Ethiopian/Portuguese raised by Jesuits, horse trainer, mercenary soldier, missing his wife Fatina.

Soren: born 1623. Mercenary soldier. Danish orphan traveling the world with his brother since age 17.

Niels: Soren's identical twin, killed October, 1648 in a battle in Prague. **Cyro** (Cyrano Duarte): born 1626, Genoese nobleman turned mercenary, hiding from his future responsibilities.

Bartal Soltesz: Hungarian Viscount. Contracted to marry Caterina.
